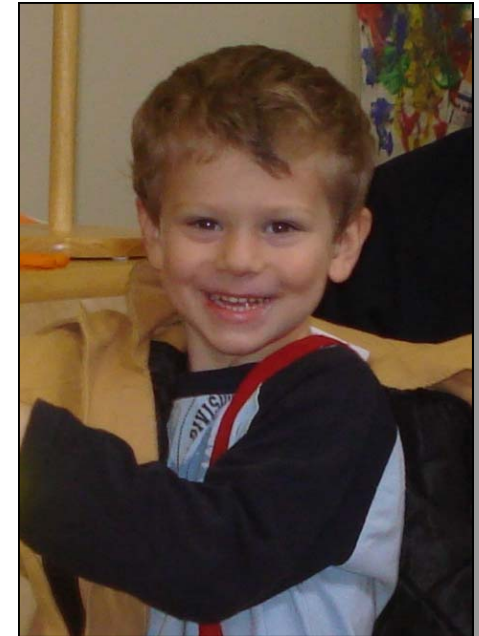

Head Start



Head Start is a quality preschool program that enrolls 3- and 4-year-old children at no cost to families*. The program's primary goal is to promote school readiness by enhancing the social and cognitive development of children.

Head Start recognizes that children learn best through hands-on experiences. Our classrooms are well-equipped with a variety of materials and resources that encourage students to explore, create, play, and learn.

Classes are led by teachers with degrees in Early Childhood Education. In addition, all classrooms have teaching assistants and classroom aides.

Head Start serves all nine school districts with locations throughout Oswego County.

Preschool...

Head Start is a comprehensive preschool program which uses a daily schedule and includes:

- large and small group times
- exploration of classroom centers
- materials to support learning in the areas of literacy, math, science, art, music, and socialization.



....and so much more!

A day at Head Start also includes nutritious meals and snacks, outdoor time, and tooth brushing.



In addition, children will learn about their community and other cultures through field trips, special events, and cooking activities.

Families are encouraged to be involved by:

- volunteering in the classrooms and kitchens,
- attending Parent/Staff conferences
- participating in parent committees.

Head Start also provides family support services, and has nurses available for questions or concerns.

Head Start supports inclusion and welcomes children with disabilities.
