## Access NY Health Care

**Facilitated Enrollment** administered by Oswego County Opportunities provides assistance to people for the accurate completion of the ACCESS NY HEALTH CARE application process for health insurance. OCO is working in partnership with the Oswego County Department of Social Services, Catholic Charities of Oswego County, Cooperative Extension of Oswego County, Pulaski Health Center/NOCHSI, Oswego Hospital and four health plans: Excellus Blue Cross Blue Shield, Fidelis Care, Total Care and United Health Care.

Enrollment facilitators located throughout Oswego County will provide an “easier” way for people to find out if they or their children are eligible for any of four programs: Child Health Plus A or B for children, and Family Health Plus or Medicaid for adults. Our mission is to help people enroll in health insurance coverage at times and locations which are convenient for them.

Health Insurance is available for children under age 19, living in NY State, through either Child Health Plus A or B. Although eligibility and benefits vary, many children may receive health insurance at little or no cost, regardless of their immigration status.

Health insurance is available for eligible adults age 19 to 64, through either Family Health Plus or Medicaid and who have limited income, who are US citizens or fall within one of many immigration categories.

Anyone eligible for participation in any of these programs may receive their health care through the participating health plan of their choice. Each health plan consists of participating doctors, hospitals and pharmacies. A Facilitated Enroller will work with you to select a plan which best meets your needs and to assure the doctor selected is a participating provider.

Facilitated enrollers are on site at locations throughout Oswego County and walk-ins are always welcome.
