



Oswego County Opportunities Mental Health Family Care Program

Community Based Family Care, is a mental health residential program operated under Oswego County Opportunities, Inc. in private homes certified by the New York State Office of Mental Health. Family Care offers a residential service that provides a home for stable adults who have a severe mental illness. We currently have two Family Care homes certified in Oswego, and Phoenix.

Residents are selected with great care to ensure that placement in a Family Care Home will be a positive experience and one in which all of the needs of the potential resident will be met.

Visits to the homes are required before a placement is made to assure that the placement is beneficial to the Resident and the others in the home.

Residents live with Providers, who are people who agree to allow those with a mental illness to live in their homes as a part of their family. Providers are carefully screened to ensure they are capable of providing the necessary care. A family, a couple or single individual who may own or rent their home or apartment may be considered as a provider. Family Care providers and homes must meet specific State and Program requirements to be certified. Providers receive monthly room and board (\$822.48) and bi-annual respite payments (\$749.00) and supplemental (\$150.00 per quarter) for this service. In addition, Family Care Providers receive monthly home visits and trainings along with staff being available 24/7 for any assistance that may be needed by Family Care Provider.
