

2018 PIT Count - SUMMARY REPORT for Oswego County

Oswego County Point-In-Time Count - Wednesday, January 24th, 2018

BRIEF SUMMARY OF RESULTS:

TOTAL - 337 surveys turned in for 2018 PIT results

2 surveys filled out by those who Met HUD definition of Homeless *Unsheltered Count = 2 Households, 3 Persons*

46 surveys filled out by those who Met HUD definition of Sheltered *Sheltered Count = 46 Households, 76 Persons (ES / T H)*

289 surveys filled out by those who did NOT meet HUD definition of Homeless

Of those surveys: 167 persons were at Imminent Risk: **54 Youth** **113 Adults**

Total = 167 Households & 302 Persons were: *AT IMMINENT RISK / On brink of Homelessness (doubled-up, in-process of eviction, housing vulnerable, or losing housing, etc.)*

(NOTE #1: These (289) surveys could not be counted for anything HUD was asking for, as they didn't meet the definition of Homeless {Sheltered or Unsheltered})

0 surveys were duplicates (not counted anywhere)
