Cut Out Clay Ornaments



3 cups of flour

1 cup of salt

Warm Water (to moisten)

Mix flour and salt and add water until it becomes a dough like consistency, then knead until smooth. Roll out dough and cut shapes from cookie cutters. Use a straw to make a hole in the top of each shape. Allow dough to air dry for a few days then paint or decorate as you choose. Thread a ribbon through the hole and hang on your tree.
